

Crafting with the Körners: 3D Hot Air Balloon

Time: Approximately 30 Minutes

Age: 7+ (Under 7 with help)

Materials List:

- Colorful cardstock (works best) or construction paper
- Yarn or string – 1 foot
- Scissors & Hole Punch
- Glue stick or liquid glue
- Cardboard roll

1. First, create your balloon template – start with one square of paper and draw a balloon shape. This will be your template – trace and cut out the shapes so you have 5 identical balloons



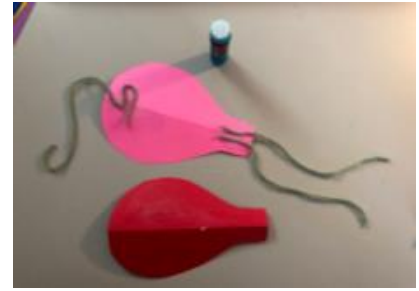
2. Next, fold all 5 pieces in half, creating a hard crease with a fingernail.



3. Cut yarn into three equal pieces. Use glue to attach one piece at top of one balloon shape, and others at bottom. Use lots of glue! And let dry for 1 minute.



4. While first shape is drying, put glue on HALF of the next balloon shape only. Smooth down the two sides to ensure a good seal. Repeat with more balloon shapes, putting glue on HALF the shape only, and making sure the yarn pieces stay sticking out of the top and bottom of the balloon shapes.



5. The balloon part is finished when all 5 shapes are glued together! Next, punch two holes in the cardboard tube to make a basket. Tie two bottom pieces of yarn to 'basket', and add decoration as desired.
